NEW CSF CAROLINAS CHAPTER

CSF has established a Carolinas Chapter at Duke University, in North Carolina. The official Chapter kick-off will take place in October 2010, in conjunction with the dedication of a memorial garden in honor of Dr. Marcy Speer. Dr. Speer's contributions as a Duke University scientist dramatically advanced our understanding of Chiari and syringomyelia.

Dr. Speer spent nearly 15 years establishing a genetic repository in order to identify specific genes associated with risk for developing Chiari. Her patient population remains one of the few Chiari genetic data sets in the entire world. In fact, she published the first genetic screen on Chiari malformation which identified several chromosomal regions that contain genes implicated in the development of Chiari. She was internationally recognized as an expert in the syndrome. On August 4, 2007, Dr. Speer lost her valiant fight with cancer.

CSF HYDRODYNAMICS SYMPOSIUM

This symposium will take place on July 1 and 2, 2011 at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH Zurich) in Zurich, Switzerland and is organized by Dr. Frank Loth (University of Akron), Dr. Dimos Poulikakos (ETH Zurich), and Dr. Vartan Kurtcuoglu (ETH Zurich)

This will be an engineering/physics focused symposium on the motion of cerebrospinal fluid (CSF). Approximately 20-30 invited speakers from around the world will speak about their research that involves either experiments or computational methods to better understand diseases related to cerebrospinal fluid motion such as hydrocephalus, Chiari malformation, and syringomyelia

This month's featured symposium organizer: Prof. Dr. Dimos Poulikakos

Dr. Poulikakos received his degree in 1978 in mechanical engineering from the National Technical University, Athens, and studied at the University of Colorado at Boulder where he earned his M.S. in 1980 and his Ph.D. in mechanical engineering in 1983. Before joining ETH Zurich, he was full professor of mechanical engineering at the University of Illinois at Chicago. He received numerous awards including the White House/NSF Presidential Young Investigator Award in 1985 and the

James H. Potter Gold Medal in Thermodynamics in 2000. He is the editor in chief of the Journal of Experimental Heat Transfer and an editor of several other journals.
